Gregory Weiss, a tenured Professor of Chemical Biology in the Departments of Chemistry, Molecular Biology and Biochemistry, and Pharmaceutical Sciences at UC Irvine, earned a BS from UC Berkeley and PhD from Harvard. Awarded an NIH postdoctoral fellowship, he pursued post-doctoral studies with Dr. Jim Wells at Genentech. In 2000, he joined the faculty at UCI. His laboratory focuses on the interface between chemistry and biology, including studies of enzymes, molecular recognition, and bioelectronics. He has been named Outstanding Professor in Physical Sciences at UCI, Beckman Foundation Young Investigator, AAAS Fellow, and won an Ig Nobel Prize. Co-founder of two biotech companies, he was named UCI's Entrepreneurial Leader of the Year in 2018 and a Faculty Innovation Fellow in 2019.
